Capernwray Hall is an interdenominational international, Christian Bible School and Holiday Centre located near Carnforth in Lancashire.


Established in 1947, it has gained a reputation as a centre for full-time studies, holidays and short-term teaching programmes aimed at enabling individuals to experience the life-changing work of Jesus Christ.

The full time study course (up to NQF Level 3) provides practical biblical instruction, equipping men and women to serve the Lord's purposes wherever they may be.

The holidays and shorter programmes provide refreshment and relaxation in an environment that enhances the teaching of the Word of God.

Capernwray accommodates up to 180 students for a year's Bible course and an equivalent number of guests for holidays and conferences. There are approximately 30 full and part time staff and a similar number of volunteers serving throughout the year. Capernwray was the founding centre of Torchbearers International which now encompasses 24 similar centres around the world.

PERSON SPECIFICATION

The person appointed will be expected to have the key essential skills, knowledge and experience listed below. The items under the heading 'desirable attributes' will also be useful for the post holder. However, candidates who do not have these desirable attributes should not be deterred from submitting an application.

Essential Skills:

- Enthusiastic and passionate about food preparation and the enjoyment it brings to clients.
- Desire to continue learning and developing.
- A team player who enjoys working with, motivating and encouraging others.
- Dependable, highly organised, with strong communication and inter-personal skills.

Knowledge and Experience:

- NVQ level 2 in professional cookery or an equivalent catering qualification.
- A good awareness of food allergies and intolerances.
- Sound knowledge and experience of health and safety requirements.

Desirable Attributes:

- 4 years' minimum catering experience in a busy kitchen.
- Experience in catering for large numbers (banqueting).
- Experience of working with and supervising volunteers.
- Experience of working in Christian residential ministry.
- Knowledge of German and / or Spanish.





- Preparation of food for students, guests, staff and volunteers. This also includes catering for guests who are staying for B & B and guests who come for special programmes or events (including weddings).
- To work with the Catering Manager in training, encouraging and supporting members of the Catering and Dining Room team, both staff and volunteers.
- To work with the Catering Manager and keeping within the budget, prepare menus and ensure that food orders are made in accordance with menu requirements. This includes the checking of deliveries of food for quality, temperature (frozen and chilled food) and training volunteers in this skill.
- To work with the Catering Manager to maintain a standard of excellence in cleaning and hygiene, especially in the kitchen and wash-up areas, and to ensure that health and safety standards are observed in all food preparation and storage areas and in the use of equipment.
- To coordinate and supervise kitchen and dining staff and student duties.
- To maintain accurate records of refrigeration, blast chiller, raw and cooked food temperatures. To
 ensure this is done in Catering Manager's absence either by yourself or those with whom you are
 working.



- To contribute to the Capernwray Holiday & Events Programme, in consultation with the Holiday Programme
 & Events Manager.
- To co-lead a 'Family Group', offering friendship, direction, pastoral nurture and encouragement to the students within it.
- To participate fully and warmly in Capernwray's community life, including attendance at staff meetings, prayer meetings and social events, and to assist in other elements of the ministry's functioning as prove necessary and reasonable.
- To identify and source opportunities and resources for continuing personal and professional development, in consultation with the Catering Manager.
- As required, to promote and represent Capernwray locally and nationally in consultation with the Catering Manager.
- To willingly and regularly affirm the ministry's Statement of Faith, Principles and Practices, Mission Statement and Values.



TERMS & CONDITIONS AND HOW TO APPLY

This role carries an occupational requirement for the applicant to be an active Christian and to subscribe to the ministry's Statement of Faith. Under the current UK employment legislation you will need to show you have a right to work in the UK. This will be fulfilled by showing you are a British citizen or hold a passport or national identity card showing you are a national of a European Economic Area country or Switzerland.

Salary: Related to experience and appropriate level of responsibility.

Annual Leave: 28 days per annum increased to 30 days after five years' service. Holiday year runs from April to March.

Hours of Work: 40 hours spread over 5 shifts in a 7-day working week, typically from 7am- 3 pm or 9 am- 6 pm, but may include split shifts or some earlier or later shifts..

Pension Scheme: Auto-enrolment pension scheme. Current contribution rates are 5% for employee and 7.8% employer.

Additional Benefits: The Charity provides death in service benefit and Permanent Health Insurance following successful completion of an initial period.
