



BBC SONGS OF PRAISE AT CAPERNWRAY






The funeral and thanksgiving service was held at Capernwray and was led by Ian Ellershaw.

WHAT IT'S ALL ABOUT

Anyone who knows me knows Capernwray is a pretty special place to me. I holidayed here as a kid, I studied here, I worked summers here and now I get to take my little crew here on holidays.

I love this place but more than that I love what God does in and through it. For me it's a place to exhale, a place to learn, a place to make memories, a place to laugh, a place to grow, a place to reset, a place to dream again, and a place to lean in to hear more from God. I can't tell you how ready I was for the exhale that this holiday was about to bring. If I'm honest I was tired, a little worn out - my tank was needing a good top up that's for sure and I was so ready to hear God speak afresh.

I think more than ever it's vital that we push back all the noise, all the distractions and position ourselves - to reset our posture towards Him. It's not about location - as God can speak anywhere - it's about our posture

Sometimes we are so distracted with life, work, ministry and everything in between that we miss what He is trying to say because it's distorted through the noise and busyness of life or worse still we can't hear Him at all.

I got a sense that today there are others who are tired, a little worn out still running but perhaps with an "emptyish" tank. I want to urge you to tuck yourself away even for a few hours to reposition your posture.

We need to disconnect in order to reconnect with the one who loves us and yes that will mean turning off your phone for a while, sit with Him, abide in Him and begin to feel the Father's heartbeat for you again.



And in that moment as you turn your gaze towards Him and look full in His wonderful face just imagine Him cupping your face in His hands - like that of a parent to a child and looking right into your eyes and whispering into the very depths of your heart reminding you again of whose you are and the promises He speaks over you.

DEVOTIONAL MESSAGE

AFTER ALL THESE **YEARS**

From the late 1970s, throughout the entire decade of the '80s and into early '90s I led the holiday weeks at Capernwray Hall.

Back in the day we had around 13 summer weeks, two at Easter and two more over Christmas and New Year, so I estimate I personally led more than 175 weeks, with something close to 25,000 people attending those weeks. I led, sat in, or preached at around 1700 meetings, and looked after umpteen visiting speakers.

What a privilege to be back to speak at the first 'Escape to Capernwray' week of summer 2022, after an absence of 22 years (apart from one a few years ago), 60 years since I first attended a teen week as a twelve-year-old boy, and 45 years since I first led the summer weeks.

What has changed? The physical buildings have expanded during those years, to include the beautiful rebuilt Conference Hall, the new Kitchen and Dining Hall, the Sports Hall renovated from the old swimming pool, and the more recent swimming pool. There is a zip line, go-carts (pedal variety), large

stepping stone crossing of the river Keer which runs through the property, and other smaller areas of change and improvement. The bureaucracy of legal obligations has increased in line with national obligations, all to the good of course, and with its beautiful and fairly isolated location, Capernwray must be one of the safest locations around.

What hasn't changed? The truths for which Capernwray stands. The twice daily exposition of the Scriptures, pointing people to the Living Christ and all the resources available to us in Him to live life as God first created us to live, and then, because of the Fall, redeemed us by the sacrificial death of Christ, to indwell us by His Spirit, equipping us for lives of usefulness.



The message hasn't changed, in its truthfulness at the heart of the gospel, nor in its centrality to the ministry of Capernwray. It is for this reason that guests flow through the doors of Capernwray Hall, hungry to know more, eager to soak up the ministry of the Word of God, anticipating

When these objectives cease to be a priority, and people cease to hunger for truth, the doors of Capernwray will close. But I predict that is not going to be for a very long time! Perhaps not until the Lord Jesus comes back.



leaving the place renewed in the Lord Jesus Christ. This was the goal from the beginning of Capernwray's ministry, 75 years ago, when the first summer conference took place in 1947.

GIVING

FINANCIAL UPDATE

The last two and a half years have undoubtedly been a difficult time financially for many organisations globally. We praise God for keeping our doors open to receive guests and students.

As an organisation we have seen our site go from being empty for almost 6 months, to having 60 students for Winter Bible School in 2020, then 75 students for SBS in 2021, followed by 95 in Winter Bible school in 2021 and then 110 at Spring Bible School in 2022. This is all against a backdrop of pre-pandemic numbers of 155 students for Winter Bible School and 115 for Spring Bible School.

THE TIMOTHY CAMPAIGN:

Fundraising £1m+

Our costs are rising and we are having to increasing our fees. However, our heart's desire is to make Bible School as accessible to as many to provide the most extensive financial related debt to clear (£350k) and a desire to start investing again in our infrastructure (bedrooms, windows, Beehive, etc.).

Over the same period our holiday conference numbers have gone from zero in 2020, to approximately 700 in 2021 and are currently looking like 1350 for 2022, versus a more usual number of 2200 guests over the year.

This has certainly put acute pressure on the ministry's finances with a loan taken out to help support working capital and has left us needing to solely trust in God (which is not a bad place to be).

In all of these challenges we thank God for all he has done during these years in terms of bringing people to Capernwray and transforming lives. We thank Him for all that he has provided and not least the amazing gifts we have received over these years. We have seen so many amazingly generous monthly donations, one off gifts and legacies left in wills and we are truly thankful for so many supporters of the ministry.
