Like so many others, Capernwray Hall is facing significant financial challenges. In order to ensure our ministry is in a financially viable position for years to come we need your help and are asking and praying for donations totalling £2.5 million to support three key areas.

A period of closure during the pandemic, followed by significantly reduced guest and student numbers meant it was necessary to borrow £350,000 from the bank to ensure the necessary finances were in place to remain open.

We believe our first priority is to pay back this emergency debt funding, particularly in light of rising interest rates in the UK.



Given the real increases in our underlying costs and a desire to ensure the long term sustainability of the ministry, it has been necessary to increase our fees. A core part of our vision is to ensure that the opportunity to study God's Word and experience His transformational presence is available to as many students as possible. We are therefore looking to build a student sponsorship fund so that those who are not able to cover the full fees themselves can easily access this fund.

# BUILDING PROJECTS - £650,000

We are so thankful for the beautiful and historic building and grounds we have at Capernwray. The Hall itself is a wonderful legacy and an iconic part of the Bible School and Holidays ministry. However, it needs some vital renovations

and improvements. Some key priorities are the investment in a solar panel system, renovation of the Beehive / stable cafe area, upgrades to the Main Hall social rooms, development of a worship space and refreshing our furniture.
