BACKGROUND TO CAPERNWRAY

Capernwray is an international interdenominational, Christian Bible School and Holiday Centre located in a beautiful parkland setting near Carnforth in Lancashire.

Capernwray opened in the spring of 1947 under the leadership of Major and Mrs Ian Thomas. It was here that the Capernwray Missionary Fellowship of Torchbearers was established, drawing European youth to the North of England. The Bible School was started to disciple young believers, enabling them to deepen their faith and understanding of the Scriptures.

Since that time Capernwray has grown significantly while still seeking to fulfil this vital ministry of teaching and evangelism through the Holiday and Bible School programmes. Capernwray was the founding centre of Torchbearers International which now encompasses 24 similar centres around the world and with whom Capernwray

enjoys a strong association. The international perspective of Capernwray is evidenced by the large numbers of overseas staff, guests and students. Capernwray accommodates up to 180 students or 200 guests. There are approximately 30 full and part time staff and a similar number of voluntary staff serving throughout the year.

Capernwray has gained an international reputation as a centre for full-time study and holidays aimed at enabling individuals to experience the life-changing work of Jesus Christ. The Bible School courses (Level 3, NCFE-accredited) provide practical biblical instruction, equipping men and women to serve the Lord's purposes wherever they may be. The School is accredited by the British Accreditation Council as a Short Course provider (6 and 3 month (2.5 months at present) courses which can be taken individually or sequentially) and received glowing inspection reports in May 2019 and October 2020.

The <u>Holidays</u> provide priceless opportunities to meet new friends while learning and discussing the basics of who Jesus Christ is and how He is relevant to all ages in the present day. The refreshment and relaxation in a scenic environment enhances the teaching of the Word of God.

Vision and Context:

We are looking for Trustees to augment our Board in the oversight and governance of Capernwray's Christian ministry based at Capernwray Hall, near Carnforth, Lancashire LA6 1AG.

Capernwray Missionary Fellowship of Torchbearers (CMFOT) is a Company limited by guarantee (registration number 3573958) and a registered Charity (number 1073139).

Key Facts: Staff and Finances

Organisation: Paid employees (c30), Voluntary staff annually (15 - 60), Turnover (£2.1M), Assets (£5.0M) including Capernwray Hall, staff residential properties (12) and 166 acres, Students per Bible School (100 - 160), Holiday guests annually (2000 - 2200).

Location

Board meetings will normally take place at Capernwray Hall, Lancashire or remotely. Four board meetings per year potentially plus one further strategy day. Trustees are expected to read and review papers before meetings, and each trustee may also be assigned specific responsibilities, depending on knowledge and experience. Time commitment varies, but on average 2 days per three month period.

Remuneration

The role of Trustee is not accompanied by any financial remuneration, although all reasonable travel expenses may be claimed.

Duration of Appointment

The term of appointment is 4 years initially, with the possibility of two further terms of 4 years each.





Particular skills and experience that will be valuable include:

- Financial/ Legal/ Regulatory experience, ideally associated with a Christian charity and prior Trustee experience preferred
- Commercial Leadership experience in Christian residential/educational ministry
- · Strategic direction setting for similar charitable organisations or equivalent
- Depth of theological understanding which is sympathetic to the evangelical and interdenominational nature of the ministry
- Experience in a hospitality context
- · Pastoral experience within Christian agencies or a church setting
- Safeguarding knowledge and experience



OVERVIEW OF ROLE

In the pursuit of all of the above in practice, you will:

- 1. Pray regularly for the ministry
- 2. Guard the essential distinctives of our commitment to evangelical and evangelistic Christian ministry
- 3. Ensure CMFOT applies its resources exclusively in pursuing its objectives
- 4. Contribute actively to the Board of Trustees' role in giving firm strategic direction to CMFOT
- 5. Safeguard the reputation and values of CMFOT, and by extension the Christian faith
- 6. Declare any conflict of interest/ loyalty while carrying out the duties of a Trustee
- 7. Be collectively responsible for the actions of the organisation and other trustees
- 8. Hold the Managing Director and management team to account and ensure effective and efficient administration of CMFOT
- 9. Ensure the financial stability of CMFOT
- 10. Attend meetings and read papers in advance of meetings
- 11. Actively participate in any sub-committee meetings, which may be established for specific purposes as appropriate
- 12. Keep informed and up to date with the activities of CMFOT and the wider issues which may impact its work
- 13. Work with fellow trustees in a collaborative way, using feedback to enhance Board effectiveness and performance.
- 14. Promote the ministry of Capernwray where possible in ways that prove to increase interest in all programmes.
- 15. Consider taking time to volunteer as a staff member for a holiday week/weekend or during Bible School to be alongside staff and understand the experience of students and guests at Capernwray.

You will have relevant experience and a passion for the ministries of Capernwray, able to support and promote our <u>Statement of Faith</u>, <u>Values</u> and Mission Statement:
